### Youth Soccer League FAQ's

- **I would like to coach. What do I do?**
  - To register as a coach please complete the Volunteer Coaches Questionnaire the time of participant registration.
  - Volunteer coaches may indicate interest in coaching on the participant registration form.
- **When will I know about my son and /or daughters team?**
  - Coaches will contact all participants following the coaches meeting held two weeks before the first practice.
  - Please be sure that you provide your most current email as most information will be sent through our TeamSideline App.
- **When will I find out practice and games schedules**
  - Practice schedules will be published on TeamSideline one week prior to the first scheduled practice.
  - Game schedules will be released two weeks prior the first scheduled game.
- **What does my child need to bring/wear to practices and games?**
  - Please be sure to only wear rubber cleats or gym shoes to all practices and games.
  - Water bottles are required as there are no fountains accessible from the soccer field.
  - Soccer balls may be brought to practices but it is asked that they are not brought to games.
  - Shin guards
  - Wear the grey jersey to every practice. Always bring both red and grey to games.
- **If my child decides not to participate will I get my money back?**
  - Participants may withdraw at any time however, refunds will only be issued if the withdraw request is made before team rosters are released or if a doctors note is provided proving the participant is physically unable to participate
- **When is picture day?**
  - Picture Day is scheduled for Saturday September 15, 2018. A complete picture day schedule will be released to confirm your team's picture time and location.
- **Team Sideline**
  - The Frankfort Park District will be using the TeamSideline App to communicate with parents and coaches.

Good news! Frankfort Park District is using TeamSideline to manage the Youth Soccer League Teams this season.

This means each Frankfort Park District Youth Soccer Team has its own TeamSideline Team Site – and each Team Site will include the Coach information and roster of players. Dates, times and locations for practices and games are also added as soon as they are available to be published.

  - Please be sure to add [no-reply@teamsideline.com](mailto:no-reply@teamsideline.com) to your approved senders list on your email to avoid communication issues
  - Upon registration with the Frankfort Park District Youth Soccer League you may also create your Team Sideline account.
  - Complete access to your league information will not be released to your account until closer to the start date of the league when information is ready to be published.
- How to Create an Account:
  - Go to [www.teamsideline.com/frankfort](http://www.teamsideline.com/frankfort)
  - Click the Sign In button in the top right hand corner.
  - Once in the Sign In Page you will click “create new account”
  - Use the email the email you provided at registration and create your TeamSideline password, to sign in to the Frankfort Park District site.
  - If you are unsure of the email you provided please contact the Frankfort Park District. If the wrong email is used you will not gain access to your teams Team Site.
  - Please remember that you will not have access to all of your participant/s information until it has been published by the Frankfort Park District Recreation Supervisor.
- Why TeamSideline
  - Once in TeamSideline you can do things like click the Communication tab to communicate with your team, or click the Family & Friends tab to invite other family members and friends to get information about your team, such as game dates, times and locations.
  - TeamSideline is easy to use and helps make the Season fun for all. You’ll never need to ask when or where a game is again.
