



Coronavirus Disease Update 11.19.20

In response to the Executive Order issued on November 17, 2020 the Frankfort Park District has **cancelled in-person** recreation programming. This is effective Friday, November 20, 2020. The Founders Center office will be closed effective end of day November 20. During the closure, maintenance and administrative staff will be working to maintain facilities and to manage the District.

The District's understand the importance of the parks to our residents as an opportunity to have access to areas for fitness and to the outdoors. The Frankfort Park District parks remain **OPEN**, including park amenities. *Be advised that the amenities in these areas are NOT sanitized, so use with caution and follow the CDC health and safety guidelines.*

- **You MUST wear mask when visiting the parks!**
- Continue to social distance and avoid gatherings in groups. Limit your group to members of your immediate household.
- Public bathrooms are closed for the season. Plan accordingly and bring hand sanitizer with you.

Program Cancellations - Park District staff are communicating to participants the status of the individual programs. If you were registered in a cancelled program, in the near future, you will receive a credit or refund for programs that haven't started and a pro-rated credit for programs that can't be rescheduled that are affected by this closure. Refunds will be processed in the coming weeks and participants will receive an email notification on the status of the refund.
