Dear Frankfort Park District Residents,

As the upcoming holiday season approaches, it is our hope you and your family remain healthy. Safety is the priority as Park District navigates the changing Covid-19 environment. On November 30, the Governor announced it would be another several weeks before there would be consideration to lifting the Tier 3 mitigation.

The stay home advisory and recommendations are to help decrease the positivity rate and assist in preventing the spread of Covid-19.

### **Tier 3 Mitigation Remains in place through mid-December**

- Participate in essential activities only
- Limit gatherings of mixed households
- Travel only if necessary
- Work from home if possible

### **The following remain in place for the Frankfort Park District**

- The Founders Center Administrative office and buildings remain closed to the public.
- ***Registrations can be dropped in the night deposit box located at the Founders Center.***
- In-Person recreational programming has been modified, postponed, cancelled or moved to a virtual platform.
- All facility rentals and user groups are canceled until further notice.
- Park District staff will continue to be available while working limited office hours or when working remotely via email and voicemail.
- **Virtual program offerings and to-go kits will be offered.**

### **Sledding & Outdoor Ice Rinks**

If enough snow falls for the hill to be used for sledding, users would be required to comply with the Tier 3 mitigation. Users will be required to wear masks and maintain social distancing.

The outdoor ice rink has not been constructed. The size of the rinks do not allow for social distancing. If the Tier 3 mitigation is lifted, the rink construction will be evaluated. Updates will be posted to the District's website and social media.

### **Reopening**

The Park District is continually monitoring the States' Reopening Plans. When updates to the current mitigation plan are announced, the Park District will work to resume programming. The Park District will follow regulations provided from the CDC and IDPH.

### **Winter Brochure**

The Winter Brochure will be available online in early December, it will not be printed or mailed. The Park District anticipates that programming in the brochure will move forward. If necessary, adjustments and updates will be made online.
