We would like to welcome you to the Frankfort Park District’s Dance program. To help promote a quality dance class benefiting all the participants, your cooperation on the following will be appreciated:

- 1.) To encourage freedom of movement and correct body placement, proper dance attire is required. A leotard, shorts and tights should be worn. Hip Hop/Jazz students may wear tight knit jazz pants with a t-shirt. Jeans, loose fitting and bulky clothes are not appropriate.
- 2.) Dance shoes are required. The Shop Nimbley site is an option for all your dance needs.

- 3.) PLEASE...have younger children use the bathroom before class. No gum or hanging jewelry permitted in class. Hair should be pulled back off face and neck. All jackets and street shoes should remain in the waiting area. Dance bags should be brought into the studio if changing shoes for another class.
- 4.) Students will enter the dance studio as the previous class is dismissed. Parents should wait in the lobby area. To help keep our lesson schedule exactly on time and to avoid disturbing a class in progress, please be punctual when dropping off and picking up your child.
- 5.) There will be a parent viewing on the last day of class.
- 6.) Session I will be devoted to learning and advancing the basic steps and positions in dance. Session II will continue this progression but also add a dance routine in preparation for our Spring Recital Presentation.
- 7.) All students registered for Session II are invited to participate in our annual Recital Presentation. An additional cost for a costume will be incurred for those who wish to participate. There will also be a small additional charge for admission to the show to cover expenses.(will have more information by the Winter/Spring session).
