IGNITE CHEERLEADING

Our cheer classes are a great way to introduce your athlete to the sport of cheerleading. Athletes will learn level appropriate skills including but not limited to cheers, dance, jumps, motions and beginner stunts. Classes are held in two sessions; Fall & Winter/Spring. Each 14-week session will end with an in-house competition between all of our locations. In our 55-minute classes held once a week, coaches follow a detailed lesson plan to ensure that each student is learning while having fun. During the last class of the session, students will showcase everything they learned. The Ignite In-House Recreational Competition is OPTIONAL. If your athlete chooses to compete, there is a \$50 competition fee and a \$160 uniform fee. Uniforms remain the same until your athlete grows out of it (normally last up to two years). In order to participate, you need to also register with Ignite at ignitecheerleading.com. You will then receive a waiver and parent handbook, which explains in detail payment for
