

Where do your local property tax dollars go?

The chart below represents the breakdown of Frankfort residents' property taxes. The pie chart is a breakdown of the percentage of property taxes collected by local taxing bodies. The Frankfort Park District represents 2.48% of your total property tax bill. The local school Districts, District 157C and High School District Lincolnway 210, represent 66.8% of the tax bill, Frankfort Fire District is 8.65% followed by the Village of Frankfort at 4.82% which includes the Village's Road funding. The Frankfort Library's tax rate is slightly lower than the Park District. However, the Library receives property tax revenue funding from unincorporated Frankfort Square property owners.

What is the Frankfort Park District's Tax Rate compared to other Park Districts in the area?

The local taxing body's tax rate and your home's Equal Assessed Value (EAV) determine the amount of funding that an agency receives from each property tax bill. Collectively, the properties within the Frankfort Park District taxing district represent a high EAV. However, the low tax rate that the Frankfort Park District has results in less funding than surrounding Park District. This level of funding impacts the Park District ability to maintain current assets and invest in new recreational facilities. Frankfort Square Park District, which is separate from the Frankfort Park District, has a tax rate of .6396 which is .4112 greater than Frankfort Park District tax rate.
