

Dear Frankfort Park District Residents,

Re: Park District must consider Referendum for 2024 ballot

 $The \ Park \ District \ is \ not \ exempt \ from \ the \ effects \ associated \ with \ inflation. \ Higher \ cost \ to \ do \ business, \ coupled \ with \ mandated \ minimum$ wage increases and the Districts stale tax rate continues to jeopardize the District's ability to maintain and replace aging assets.

The Park District works to provide quality programs and recreation facilities to the residents of Frankfort. In 2022, the Park District had a referendum on the ballot to ask voters for a tax rate increase that would generate additional money to fund the rising operating costs of the Park District. The tax rate measure did NOT pass.

This has resulted in the Park District redirecting money for events to operational costs and reducing services. This concerned some local sponsors which have assisted the District to continue to offer a number of free community events that were going to be cut.

The Park District collects \$1.8 million in property taxes allocated to operate and maintain 19 neighborhood parks and playgrounds and 65,000 sq. ft of indoor space, most of which was constructed prior to 1970's.

The current level of funding is not enough to cover the minimum required to responsibly maintain the resident's assets that the Park District has been appointed to preserve. Unlike other local government agencies, the Park District has never had a tax rate increase or bond issue approved by voters that allow the District to accumulate cash reserve that can sustain the growth and increased costs.

In 2024, the Park District will be asking residents again to consider a vote on for a tax rate increase referendum and consideration for a bond issue to repair existing facilities or to construct a new facility. Please follow our social media and website to learn more as we share with residents the financial challenges and facility needs of the district.

The goal of the Park District remains to provide quality recreation services and facilities at a reasonable cost.

Senator Hastings Secures Over \$1.5 Million for Park Replacement

Partnerships are key to a successful operation. The Frankfort Park District would like to celebrate our partnership and friendship with Senator Michael Hastings who serves the 19th District.

Senator Hastings is committed to making sure that Southland receives funding for projects that enhance the quality of life for its residents. The funding Senator Hastings has allocated to the Frankfort Park District has helped with additional funds outside of our levy to fill the gaps in the district's budget allowing us to update recreation facilities for our residents. In the past two years, Senator Hastings has secured \$750,000 for the splash pad and Lincoln Meadows Park improvements and \$175,000 in OSLAD funding for Windy Hill.

The Frankfort Park District has a long list of deferred capital projects. One of the projects that is looming is the replacement of Fort Frankfort playground at Commissioners Park. The playground was constructed in 1997 and is due for replacement in the near future. The "Fort" is special, Frankfort residents via Operation Playground Foundation, raised funds to finance the project and physically assisted to build the structure. To continue the legacy of the "Fort" it will take over a million dollars to replace. Given the limited budget of the Park District, the replacement of the "Fort" even with assistance from Operation Playground Foundation and submitting for a matching grant from the State of Illinois the likelihood seemed grim.

We are happy to announce funding has been provided! Senator Michael Hastings has secured over \$1.5 million in funding through the Rebuild Illinois Project Fund to replace the Fort Frankfort playground!!! This level of funding will allow for an inclusive design that removes the physical barriers allowing all abilities to play together. In the coming months, staff will be reaching out to the community to get feedback on designs concepts. This is an exciting opportunity for the residents of Frankfort. A special thank you to Senator Hastings for including Frankfort residents and the Park District in his planning.

Windy Hill OSLAD Project Update

The Park District has finalized the design and received approval from the OSLAD grant staff for the Windy Hill Park Improvements. This park project was awarded an OSLAD grant from the State of Illinois that matches the districts contribution for a total project of \$350,000. The project was bid this summer and construction is anticipated to start in the spring of 2024. The funding provided by the OSLAD grant allowed for expanded park improvements which have a nature-based design. The improvements include a playground, fitness area, solar powered charging stations and foot paths.





Lincoln Meadows Ribbon Cutting

The installation of the Lincoln Meadows Ninja/ Challenge course was completed in June. The Park District held a ribbon cutting on July 25th. The \$400,000 project was funded with DCEO funds from the State that were secured by Senator Hastings. The event included an opportunity for attendees to test the course which has a solar powered timing mechanism.

Founders Center Gym Remains Offline

Earlier this year, the Park District found structural deficiencies in the Founders Center Gym. The gym is currently stabilized but is not available for programs or rentals which is impacting the operation of the district programing. The Founders Center was constructed in 1938, and the gym was added in 1957.

For the last couple of years, the District has been advocating for a tax rate increase which is desperately needed to preserve the residents' assets. Just like your home, it is necessary to maintain, update and repair buildings and infrastructure. When that is postponed the amount of money needed increases.

The Founders Center has a number of areas that need attention immediately including replacement of multiple roofs, aging plumbing, failed air conditioning and structural issues. The Park District is awaiting a decision if the structural issues will be covered by insurance that would repair the structure deficiency. If the claim is denied, some hard decisions will need to be made. Given the number of costly projects that are needed, the Park District will be seeking input from residents on consideration to construct a new facility to replace the Founders Center.

Funds to construct a new facility or improve the existing facility would require a bond referendum supported by voters. The Frankfort Park District tax rate has been stale since the early 90's and holds as one of the lowest tax rates of park district in the south suburbs. These two constraints limit the Park District's ability to improve and construct new recreation facilities.

Preschool





-Start of School -

Preschool classes for the fall will begin the week of September 4th (after Labor Day) and run through May 2024. Orientation days are scheduled on Tuesday & Wednesday, September 5th & 6th. You will be sent an email reminder with your child's class orientation date and time.

Please note: This is not a regular school day. Please plan on staying with your child on this day. Your children will stay all by themselves at the next scheduled class session. Please bring school supplies on this day.

REGISTRATION

All preschool programs run from September 2023 to May 2024. Registration takes place at the Founders Community Center at 140 Oak Street, Frankfort and can only be done IN

PERSON. A copy of the child's birth certificate is required at the time of registration for new participants.

A \$50 non-refundable registration fee is due at the time of registration. AUTO - PAYMENT will be mandatory for the monthly payment option (see form in preschool packet). Auto-payment forms MUST be turned in upon registration. You may also pay in full for the entire year. Call the Park District at 815-469-9400 if you have any questions or would like to visit our programs while they are in session.

WEE WORKS 2.5 YEARS

This twice-weekly program is perfect for young children anxious to meet friends. The class will be filled with playtime, arts & crafts, stories, music, and snack time. The child must be 2.5 years old by September 1, 2023. Being toilet trained is NOT mandatory. A physical is required.

PREP SCHOOL 4 YEARS

Field trips are taken, and a physical is required.

PRAIRIE CARE Before & After School Care Program

The Prairie Care program is designed to provide a safe, recreational based program for children attending **District**

157C schools in grades Kindergarten – 5th grade. The program is coordinated by qualified staff who strive to develop a warm constructive relationship with the children. Prairie Care provides a creative and stimulating environment in which children can learn, grow and thrive at their own developmental pace.

Regular hours of the program will be from 6:30 AM until school begins and then from the end of school until 6:30 PM. Most district institute days are available. ALL BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMS WILL FOLLOW THE SCHOOL DISTRICT POLICY ON SNOW DAYS - CLOSED.

Registration and payments are due on Wednesday two weeks prior to the month of requested service. Your payment will reserve your spot for the month. 



FRANKFORT ON POINTE

The On-Pointe Dance program is a progressive program open to children ages 3 years and older. Students will be divided according to experience level in the following classes.

Little Stars: This is a gentle introductory class that includes learning to move to music and developing motor and listening skills in a fun, creative environment.

Pre-Ballet: This beginner class introduces basic ballet technique through fun movement while focusing on coordination skills and self-expression.

Ballet/Tap/Jazz Combo: A combination of ballet, tap and jazz. This combination class will build on foundational skills of ballet, the styles of tap and upbeat fast paced movement of jazz to help with coordination, flexibility, and musicality. Fun dance routines and up to date music make kids excited to come back week to week.

Ballet I: More advanced stretching and strengthening exercises are given, barre work is introduced with a greater emphasis on vocabulary and French terminology.

Jazz: Emphasis is on the importance of energy, rhythmical accuracy, and style. Each level of jazz is a continuation of the previous level and increases in difficulty.

Jazz/Hip Hop III: Emphasis on popping, locking, and other hip-hop movements that are utilized in only Hip-Hop dance. Must be 13 and older for this class.

Lyrical III: In this class we will combine techniques learned in ballet and jazz to create movements performed to music with lyrics. This is a great way to inspire movement & expression of emotions based on the dancer's interpretation of the music.

Dance Troupe: In order to enroll in this class, you must also be in Jazz 1, 2, or 3 and Ballet 1, 2, or 3 for the Dance Troupe program. We have three different age levels for competition. Petite, Junior, and Senior groups. Age decides what group you are in. Troupe does local dance competitions during the year (a final number has not been decided on). This class also has a strict attendance policy, and you must attend all classes. If you miss 2 or more classes, you will be dropped from the Dance Troupe.
