Dear Frankfort Park District Residents,

This past year you may have noticed changes in the community parks. The Park District is not exempt from the effects associated with inflation. In 2022, the Park District had a referendum on the ballot to ask voters for a tax rate increase that would generate additional money to fund the rising operating cost. The tax rate measure did NOT pass.

With limited funding, the Park District has made choices of where to allocate funds. Perhaps you noticed the changes. To reduce costs, the frequency of mowing the parks was reduced. At times this was manageable but with the wet and warm weather the grass in some areas appeared overgrown. The District has continued to invest funds into managing the ponds and weed control so as not to compromise the past investments in these areas. Support from community partners funded numerous community events that were going to be cancelled, this included the July 4th fireworks.

The facilities owned by the District are aging and with that there is our increased maintenance and costly repairs that are needed. In February, it was determined that the Founders Center gym bow-string truss system failed, and repairs were necessary. The Park District is investing \$300,000 in the gym that will make it safe and operational. However, the repairs to the gym do not improve the functionality or aesthetics of the gym. The Founders Center has other areas that require repairs including leaking roofs, parking lot resurfacing and HVAC issues. The question staff and the Commissioners struggle with is with limited funds is prioritizing projects and deciding how much you invest into a facility that has challenges to meet the needs of the community. The Founders Center is just one of the aging facilities that the District owns that requires ongoing maintenance. With limited funding, the Board continues to evaluate where to put resources and what can be managed each year.

The current level of funding is not enough to cover the minimum required to responsibly maintain the resident's assets that the Park District has been appointed to preserve. Unlike other local government agencies, the Park District has never had a tax rate increase or bond issue approved by voters that allow the District to accumulate cash reserve that can sustain the growth and increased costs.

In 2024, the Park District will be asking residents again to consider a vote on for a tax rate increase referendum and consideration for a bond issue to repair existing facilities or to construct a new facility. Please follow our social media and website to learn more as we share with residents the financial challenges and facility needs of the district.

The goal of the Park District remains to provide quality recreation services and facilities at a reasonable cost.

#### PARK DISTRICT NEWS

#### Fort Frankfort - Preserving the Past - Planning for the Future

In 1999, the Frankfort Park District was looking for a big idea to improve the newly acquired Commissioners Park, but the capital budget was limited. Community members came up with the idea and a goal to build a playground with volunteers, private financing, and do it in eight months! The children of Frankfort chose the name and contributed ideas to the park design. Committees were formed and the project began.

Operation Playground Foundation was established for fundraising purposes with a goal of raising \$120,000. Through a variety of community events the funds were raised to complete the project.

Working 3 shifts a day, 75-120 volunteers gave their time. The dream of so many was realized on October 17, 1999 – Fort Frankfort was complete! The Fort Frankfort Playground was a realization of the efforts of the Frankfort community members.

Operation Playground Foundation continues to raise money which is invested in the Frankfort community parks. Over the last four decades, OPF has funded the construction of the Bark Park, 3-on-3 Basketball courts, the Judy Herder Pump Track and pickleball courts.

#### Funding Provided to Replace Fort Frankfort - 2023

The Fort Frankfort playground is 24 years old and needs repairs. With limited funding for capital projects, the Park District had concerns if funding for a new park would be available. This year, Senator Michael Hastings secured \$1.75 million dollars from the State of Illinois for the renovation of the Fort Frankfort Playground. The Park District is looking to honor the past and preserve the vision of the residents and efforts invested in the Fort Frankfort Playground.

Over the coming months, the Park District will be engaging the community to get input on the park design. The funding level will allow design to offer inclusive play elements taking away the physical and social barriers creating equitable play for all. Please visit the Frankfort Park District's website and social media pages to provide feedback on conceptual designs. Construction of the new playground is anticipated to take place at the end of the summer in 2024. The upcoming months will include opportunities for input from the community.

Fort Frankfort was funded, constructed, and is maintained by Operation Playground Foundation.

## Preschool/Prairie Care





#### **REGISTRATION**

All preschool programs run from September 2024 to May 2025. Registration begins Monday, February 5, 2024, for indistrict residents. Non-residents will begin Monday, February 12, 2024. Registration takes place at the Founders Community Center at 140 Oak Street, Frankfort, and can only be done IN PERSON. A copy of the child's birth certificate is required at the time of registration for new participants.

A \$60 non-refundable registration fee is due at the time of registration. \*If your tuition is paid in full between May 1 and July 15, 2024, you will receive a 5% discount for the entire year. For Non-residents, the discount will be taken off the resident rate. AUTO - PAYMENT will be mandatory for the monthly payment option (see form in preschool packet). Autopayment forms MUST be turned in by July 15, 2024. Please have all paperwork turned in by July 15 to confirm your registration commitment. Call the Park District at 815-469-9400 if you have any questions or would like to visit our programs while they are in session.

#### **WEE WORKS 2.5 YEARS**

This twice-weekly program is perfect for young children anxious to meet friends. The class will be filled with playtime, arts & crafts, stories, music, and snack time. The child must be 2.5 years old by September 1, 2024. Being toilet trained is NOT mandatory. A physical is required.

#### PREP SCHOOL 4 YEARS



#### **OPERATION PLAYGROUND FOUNDATION**

Operation Playground is a 501(c)(3) organization and was established in 2000 by a group of volunteers in Frankfort, Illinois. Its initial project was the construction of Fort Frankfort, a children's park which is situated within Commissioner's Park located at Laraway Road and S. 80th Ave. Operation Playground's second major project was Frankfort Bark Park, a dog park with a state-of-the-art gate and monitoring system. The dog park, which opened in May 2007 sits on three acres of land at the northwest corner of Commissioner's Park.
