I love summer. The longer days filled with sunlight offer more opportunities to enjoy life outdoors. I'm especially grateful to everyone who enrolled in Park District programs, attended our Park Parties, or simply spent time in our parks. Your participation brings our community to life. During the summer months, the Park District team nearly doubles in size. These seasonal staff members play a vital role in supervising campers, managing the parks, operating the Splash Pad, and leading our programs. Their hard work makes everything we do possible. Many of them are now preparing to head back to school, and we offer a heartfelt thank you for their

You may have seen recent communications from the Park District regarding the Recreation Center survey. This year, we're asking for your feedback on a critical topic: Would you support a property tax increase to fund the construction of a new Recreation Center? Yes, we are talking about a potential increase in property taxes. There is never an easy time to discuss this, but it's important for two

Reason #1: Our current facilities are aging and in need of significant repairs. The Park District manages 19 parks and two programming facilities, and we receive less than \$2 million annually in unrestricted property taxes. These funds are used for daily operations, maintenance, staffing, and minor improvements. The truth is, there's not enough funding to address the major infrastructure needs, particularly for our indoor facilities. We've been fortunate to receive grants from the State of Illinois for outdoor projects, but indoor facility needs remain underfunded. One example is the Founders Center, a nearly 100-year-old building that requires substantial repairs. Without additional funding, we simply can't address these issues.

Reason #2: Residents consistently ask for better indoor recreation opportunities. Each week, we hear questions like, "Where's the pool? Where's the Recreation Center? Why don't we have the same amenities as nearby communities?" The answer comes down to funding. The current level of property tax support isn't enough to build or maintain the facilities our community is requesting. The Founders Center was once a middle school, and it no longer meets the needs or expectations of modern recreation programming. New funding is needed to build a facility that reflects our residents' desires.

That's why we're asking you to take the Recreation Center survey. It takes less than five minutes and will help us understand whether there is enough community support to move forward. Please answer the survey as if you were voting in a local election. There are no

If the community is not ready to support a new Recreation Center, we will continue to prioritize projects based on available funding. However, this may mean delaying or scaling back essential improvements, such as playground replacements and program offerings. Thank you for being part of our community. We look forward to hearing your voice.



#### The New Fort Frankfort Playground Is Taking Shape!

We're thrilled to share that construction on the new Fort Frankfort playground is nearing completion! This much-anticipated project has been made possible thanks to \$1.7 million in funding secured by Senator Hastings from the State of Illinois through the DCEO Grant. Without this generous support, the project would not have been possible.

The new design pays tribute to the beloved original Fort Frankfort structure and celebrates the unique character of the Frankfort community. The larger of the two new playgrounds features a Grainery reminiscent of the one in downtown Frankfort, along with a signature water tower. The playground will also include poured-in-place surfacing and accessible ramps to ensure inclusive play for children of all abilities.

To enhance the park experience, two large shelters are being constructed to serve both playground and Splash Pad users. Portions of the project have also been funded by the Park District through capital funds and with generous support from the Operation Playground Foundation (OPF). OPF is made up of dedicated community members who led the original Fort Frankfort installation and continue to actively support park projects in Frankfort.

### Storms, Determination, and Community Spirit Mark the 25th Annual Short Run on a Long Day 5K

The 25th Annual Short Run on a Long Day 5K Run/Walk turned into a true test of grit and spirit as participants braved a wild mix of weather that included heavy downpours and steady rain. Despite ominous forecasts, 440 runners and walkers registered for this milestone event. As thunderclouds rolled in and the skies opened up, 318 determined participants crossed the finish line—drenched but undeterred. The course, already a local favorite for its community charm and summer solstice setting, became an unforgettable challenge as sections were inundated with standing water and pounding rain.

Volunteers and organizers worked tirelessly through the storm to ensure safety of all attendees while maintaining the celebratory spirit, for which the event is widely recognized. Emergency weather protocols were on standby, but thanks to vigilant monitoring and some lucky timing, the race was able to go on without incident. "Our 25th year certainly gave us a story to tell," said Cali DeBella, Recreation Supervisor and race coordinator. "This was about more than running—it was about community, resilience, and the kind of fun you never forget."

As the rain cleared and medals were handed out under a soaking sky, participants laughed, and posed for photos - muddy shoes and all - a fitting finish for a race that embodied the meaning of perseverance.

### Preschool





#### PRESCHOOL REGISTRATION

All preschool programs run from September 2025 to May 2026. Registration began in February and takes place at the Founders Community Center at 140 Oak Street, Frankfort,

and can only be done IN PERSON. A copy of the child's birth certificate is required at the time of registration for new participants. Spaces are limited.

A \$75 non-refundable registration fee is due at the time of registration. AUTO-PAYMENT will be mandatory for the monthly payment option (see form in preschool packet). Call the Park District at 815-469-9400 if you have any questions or would like to visit our programs while they are in session.

#### **WEE WORKS 2.5 YEARS**

This twice-weekly program is perfect for young children anxious to meet friends. The class will be filled with playtime, arts & crafts, stories, music, and snack time. The child must be 2.5 years old by September 1, 2025. Being toilet-trained is NOT mandatory. A physical is required.

#### **PLAY SCHOOL 3 YEARS**

This program will provide time for young children to learn how to interact with their peers. Fun activities help the children learn to share and follow directions. Colors, numbers, and the alphabet are introduced. The child must be 3 years old by September 1, 2025, and MUST be toilet trained. A physical is required.

### -Start of School

Preschool classes will begin the week of September 2nd (after Labor Day) and run through May 2026. Teacher Meet & Greet days are scheduled on Tuesday & Wednesday, September 2nd & 3rd. Meet and Greet class schedule will be provided in your preschool packet. You will be sent an email reminder with your child's Teacher Meet & Greet date and time.

Please note: This is not a regular school day. Please plan on staying with your child on this day. Your children will stay all by themselves at the next scheduled class session. Please bring school supplies on this day.

#### PREP SCHOOL 4 YEARS

This Kindergarten preparation program is for children who will be 4 years old by September 1, 2025, and MUST be toilet trained. The curriculum includes age-appropriate activities for language arts, math, science, motor skills, and socialization. Field trips are also taken. A physical is required.

#### **STEPPING STONES 4 YEARS**

This 5-day program will focus on school readiness skills of language arts, math, science, and fine motor skills. Emphasis is also placed on improving social skills. Field trips are taken, and a physical is required.

### Prairie Care



#### PRAIRIE CARE Before & After School Care Program

The Prairie Care program is designed to provide a safe, recreational-based program for children attending District 157C schools in grades Kindergarten – 5th grade. The program is coordinated by qualified staff who strive to develop a warm, constructive relationship with the children. Prairie Care provides a creative and stimulating environment in which children can learn, grow, and thrive at their own developmental pace.

Regular hours of the program will be from 6:30 AM until school begins, and then from the end of school until 6:30 PM. Most district institute days are available. ALL BEFORE AND AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAMS WILL FOLLOW THE SCHOOL DISTRICT POLICY ON SNOW DAYS - CLOSED.

Registration and payments are due on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of the month, prior to the month of requested service. Your payment will reserve your spot for the month. Please see the current Prairie Care registration forms for more information. You may drop off your payments at the Frankfort Park District at 140 Oak Street or the Prairie Care site (if turned in on time). You may also email registration forms to registration@frankfortparks.org. All forms are available on our website at www.frankfortparks.org. No same-week registration. Late fees will apply at the discretion of Prairie Care staff.

#### PRIORITY REGISTRATION

Due to high demand for Prairie Care we are implementing a priority registration period for participants who are registering for 4 or more days each week. This approach ensures that participants with a greater commitment to the program are offered priority access to available spots in the aftercare program. Priority registration must be submitted by the first Wednesday of each month for the following month. All other participants may submit their registration forms thereafter, with a deadline on the second Wednesday of the month (pending any holiday adjustments). Registration will be processed based on availability, and participants willl be notified if a specific day is at capacity.

#### **DISTRICT HOLIDAYS**

Participants of Prairie Care and other students in 157C may register for all District Holidays/Early Dismissals on a per-day basis except for Spring Break. Below are Prairie Care offerings on the dates that 157C students are off school. Labor Day weekend, Thanksgiving week, Winter Break, and Memorial Day are not available.

Note: There must be a minimum of 12 participants to run this program. You do not have to be a regular participant of Prairie Care to sign up for the District Holidays/Early Dismissal Days.

#### FRANKFORT ON-POINTE

The On-Pointe Dance program is a progressive program open to children ages 3 years and older. Students will be divided according to experience level in the following classes.

**Little Stars:** This is a gentle introductory class that includes learning to move to music and developing motor and listening skills in a fun, creative environment.





Its initial project was the construction of Fort Frankfort, a children's park which is situated within Commissioner's Park located at Laraway Road and S. 80th Ave. Operation Playground's second major project was Frankfort Bark Park, a dog park with a state-of-the-art gate and monitoring system. The dog park, which opened in May 2007 sits on three acres of land at the northwest corner of Commissioner's Park. The latest projects include funding of the 3-on-3 basketball half courts at Main Park and the installation of the Ga-ga pit and Pickle Ball Courts at Commissioners Park.
